
TDS responded to the tornadoes that impacted Mississippi. The storm's damage spanned over 200 miles. TBUSA hired a Program Manager to head up the New Orleans TDS warehouse that will transition to a Community ToolBank in 2024. Work continues in Louisiana for long-term recovery and rebuilding from Hurricane Ida. TBUSA hired Matt Walenciak, Director of Replication and Sustainability.



TDS responded to Hurricane Idalia that impacted the Big Bend in Florida. TBUSA partnered with Grainger employees for a 4,000-disaster relief bucket assembly day. TDS began distribution of the kits to those impacted by disasters and as a measure for disaster preparedness.
